AUTHOR GUIDELINES

Persons wishing to present at the SAFE Europe Symposium are requested to submit an abstract and biography prior to the event and a PDF copy of their presentation after the event.

DEADLINES

End of January for abstract and biography
(Please note that full papers are no longer required)

ABSTRACTS

For the symposium, authors are requested to submit an abstract, no longer than 450 words (including title, author list and affiliation), that should include the following information:

- > Title
- > Author(s) and affiliation/company
- > Introduction and aim of presentation
- > Technical outline including data
- > Conclusions and recommendations

Submitted abstracts should be font type Arial, 11 point and single line. The title should be in bold and the authors list presented with surname and then initial of first name.

ORAL PRESENTATION

The Symposium offers an international group of professionals the opportunity to share problems and solutions in the related fields of safety and survival. Abstracts and presentations are invited from industry, military and academia. Although the symposium is keen to hear about new products, all presentations should include technical data about the development, testing and/or clearance of any such equipment. Presentations should not be a 'sales led' presentation.

Session presentations will be allocated 25 minutes, with 5 minutes for questions. All sessions will be chaired to ensure that presenters do not exceed their allocated time.

All oral presentations will be delivered in a PowerPoint format.

BIOGRAPHY

All authors are also required to submit a short biography (150 to 200 words) when submitting abstracts. Biographies will be included in the conference proceedings. Please include your biography at the beginning of your abstract submission.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

All abstracts will be subject to review by the scientific committee. Abstracts that do not meet the remit of the symposium may be rejected. Authors of approved abstracts will be invited to deliver an oral presentation.

BEST PAPER

SAFE Europe actively encourages presentations of high technical quality by offering an award of 'best paper'. A selected panel of judges will make the final decision on best paper, which will be based on technical content, novelty and presentation style.

The winning recipient of the 'best paper' will also be offered the opportunity to present their presentation at SAFE Association USA during the same year – typically October/November. A contribution to the costs of attending the symposium will be offered.
